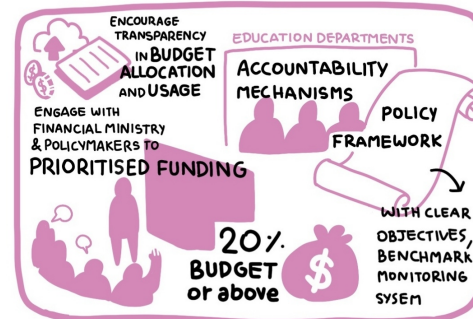


Deep Dive: KATT Legacy One | Budget Priority Survey

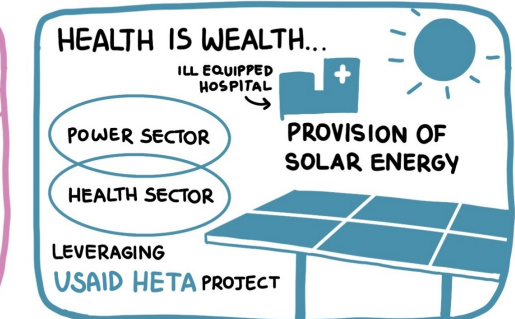

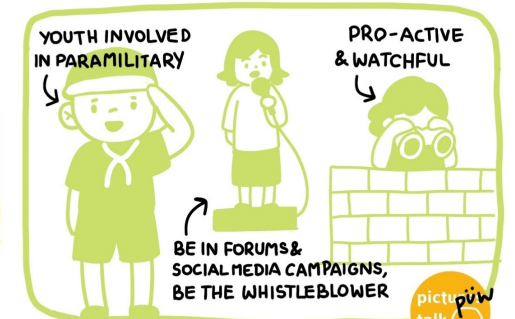

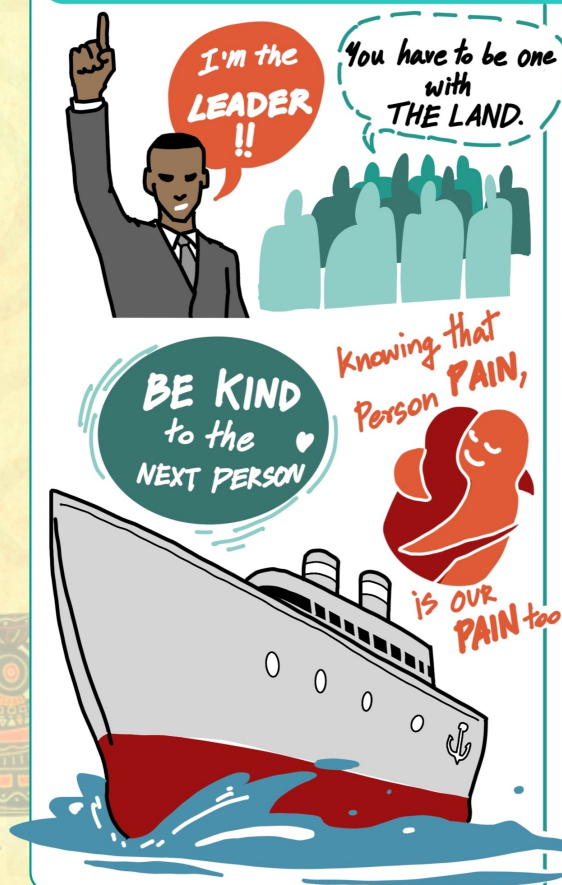
